Installing OAT 1.0.2 for ENVI 5.4+ under Windows

0 Introduction

This document describes the procedure for installing the OMEGA Analysis Tool (OAT) for use with ENVI 5.4 and above.

1 How to Install OAT under Windows

These instructions describe the process for installing this version of OAT on Windows, whether or not you have a previous version installed.

- 1. If there is a previous installation of OAT on your computer, delete C:\Program Files\OAT_ENVI, or rename it if you wish to save the previous version of OAT. This may require administrator rights, and may require ENVI and IDL to be closed.
- 2. Extract the folder OAT_ENVI from the OAT zip archive. Move OAT_ENVI to C:\Program Files\ (requires admin rights).
- 3. In the IDL console, run the following commands to compile OAT. Copying and pasting one line at a time into the console is an effective way to do this.

.reset_session
PREF_SET, 'IDL_PATH', '+C:\Program Files\OAT_ENVI;'+pref_get('IDL_PATH'), /commit
.compile oat_menu.pro
resolve_all, /continue_on_error, skip_routines='ENVI'
save, filename = 'C:\Program Files\oat_envi\tmp\oat_menu.sav', /routines
```

- 4. Move oat_menu.sav file from the folder C:\Program Files\OAT_ENVI\tmp to the folder C:\Program Files\Harris\ENVI5X\extensions\ (inside your ENVI installation directory). If there is a previous installation of OAT, this will overwrite the previous OAT .sav file.
- 5. Restart ENVI. OAT will be in the Display menu.
